5. Reading of May 2019 Work Session and Regular Board Meeting Minutes

Ms. Hume made a motion to accept the minutes as printed. Ms. Rottier seconded the motion. Motion carried.

5. Treasure's Report for May 2019

Mr. Studer reports the water sales are down, property tax received \$9K last month, credit card rebates are \$1522.00. Coalition, computer support, electricity, and office supplies estimated to overrun budgeted number but operations over all will still finish under budget. Wages and travel are estimated to finish under budget. Mr. Studer reports all material is paid for on the credit card and FLDWID received rewards points that have been deposited into National Bank of Arizona. Ms. Rottier made a motion to accept the treasures report as presented. Ms. Hume seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr. Studer pointed out prior to starting the Main Trunk Line project FLDWID had one million dollars in the bank and today FLDWID has \$754,690.45.

6. On-Site Manager's Report for May 2019

Mr. Cooper reports 891 customers, delinquents are at \$329.18 with no customer issues. Email billing has 229 customers. Credit card rewards total \$1522.23.

Mr. Cooper states on May 21 Wildcat, Larson Loop, and Bailey Trail either lost water pressure or lost water about 8:30 am and it was restored at 11:30 am.

Mr. Cooper reports Ms. Belch has finished the CCR and ADWR. Ms. Belch has published the CCR in the Payson Round Up and there are copies at general store, fire station, and water office. Also posted on the Forest Lakes DWID website.

Mr. Cooper reports Western Grade, LLC has been paid their first payment of \$27k, Core and Main have been paid in full with the credit card. Mr. St. Germain asked Mr. Cooper about the savings. Mr. Cooper explained the \$11K savings was from any material over 4 inches cannot be charged tax.

Water pumped 2,792,711 customers used 2,692,711 and unaccountable water 100,000 gallons.

Mr. Cooper reminds Board members that signups for the fall conference in Prescott are July 5.
