1. Discussion and Review of Hydrants that Do Not Meet Standards

Mr. Studer states the communication between the Forest Lakes Fire Department and Forest Lakes DWID has been great for years now. Mr. Studer points out the 5-year plan manual states "hydrants that are not 6-inch will be upgraded during the installation of new water line upgrades." Mr. Cooper states Forest Lakes DWID is following AWWA standards. AWWA standards are as follows, during upgrade of water line hydrants that are not 6-inches will upgrade. Forest Lakes DWID has followed AWWA since FLDWID started upgrading water lines. Mr. Taylor will talk to Chief Rodriguez and write a formal letter of the communication.
